

SOURCE OF FINANCIAL SUPPORT

The U.S. Government requires Cornell to verify adequate financial support and health insurance for international visitors and their accompanying dependents. Minimum funding requirements for the J-1 student intern are \$1,800/month or \$21,600 per year. It is the hosting department's responsibility to verify that ALL exchange visitors meet minimum funding guidelines and are covered by medical insurance. Please note that medical insurance is a U.S. Government requirement.

Funding must be arranged prior to issuance of a DS-2019 form. No additional funding from Cornell University should be expected after arrival. If funds are from an organization, grant, or government support, please attach a signed copy of any letters of award or sponsorship. If on personal funds, please attach a bank statement not more than 6 months old. Proof of funding must accompany this form.
